PROTEGA Trade Fair – A Modern Approach to Safety and Rescue

In the face of increasingly frequent natural disasters, epidemic, chemical, and terrorist threats, as well as a rapidly changing geopolitical landscape, effective strategies for civil protection have become a key element of security policy. The PROTEGA Trade Fair will serve as a platform for exchanging experiences, showcasing modern technological solutions, and discussing best practices in threat prevention and response.

The premiere edition of the PROTEGA Trade Fair of Civil Protection and Civil Defence will take place on November 24–25, 2025, at the MTP Poznań Expo. It will be a landmark event for professionals involved in civil protection and defence, crisis management, and emergency response.

Fires, floods, hurricanes, chemical and ecological contamination, radiological incidents, epidemic and terrorist threats, structural and transport disasters, extreme heat and cold, as well as disruptions in utility services – these are just some of the risks that civil protection services must be prepared to face.

The aim of the PROTEGA Trade Fair is to present the wide array of issues related to crisis management, civil protection, and civil defence. During the two-day event, products and services of critical importance to emergency services, as well as national and local government representatives responsible for public safety, will be showcased.

"Our priority is to spark a broad discussion on safety in the face of both natural and man-made disasters," says Marcin Gorynia, Product Group Director at Grupa MTP. "We invite experts who save lives and health every day – including representatives of fire services and emergency medical services – as well as government and local officials responsible for ensuring citizens' safety."





The thematic scope of PROTEGA covers a wide range of topics, particularly:

- Crisis management
- Civil protection and civil defence
- Emergency response and medical aid in crisis situations
- Monitoring, warning, and public alert systems
- Communication and connectivity systems
- Collective protection facilities and their equipment
- Civil-military cooperation

The exhibition will be divided into several key thematic zones, covering both threat prevention and emergency response, as well as the use of modern technologies in crisis management systems. Exhibitors will present equipment for rescue services, innovative threat monitoring systems, advanced tools to support rescue operations, and communication and IT solutions used in crisis management centers.

"I hope that PROTEGA will become a vital fixture on the map of events dedicated to safety, civil protection, and civil defence in Poland – and even across Europe," says Dagmara Suprun, Director of the PROTEGA Trade Fair. "I am confident that expert-led panels and discussions, alongside the presentation of innovative solutions and cutting-edge rescue equipment, will turn Poznań into a hub for national and European-level safety discussions."
